


"Forgot Your Password?" link on the Log On screen to have one automatically generated and emailed to them.

- (05/02/2013) If your TX-UNPS account has been locked, you must wait AT LEAST ten full minutes before you can log in with your temporary one-time use password.
- (03/28/2013) Once a valid user name and email address is entered, an automated email will be generated and sent to the requester. This email will be from TX-UNPS Help Desk (squaremeals@TexasAgriculture.gov). Please check your spam filter if you do not receive the message.
- (03/28/2013) The email address used for the forgot password feature may be different than that used in the Contracting Entity Applications. If changes are needed, the user will need to submit a completed and valid FND-101. Identified Students are students certified for free meals through means other than individual household applications in the School Year prior to implementing the provision.

This includes both students who are directly certified and categorically eligible (including Homeless, Foster, Migrant, Head Start, Runaway and non-applicant students).

USDA-Defined Multiplier Factor

Because CEP schools do not collect household applications for school meals, the USDA defines a multiplier factor that is intended to estimate the number of free and reduced price meals that would have been served at the participating school based on income eligibility and categorical eligibility if applications were collected.

Effective July 1, 2014, then multiplier factor is 1.6. Although the factor may change, schools receiving approval by the State to implement CEP on their SNP Application Packet are guaranteed the factor determined in the initial year for an entire 4-year cycle.

Potentially Eligible

Schools with an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) that is less than 40 percent, but greater than or equal to 30 percent, may be eligible to participate in CEP in the subsequent year if they meet the eligibility requirements.




