## Section 1

Total Schools, Residential Child Care Institutions (RCCIs), and Enrolled Students

### Data Entry Errors

Data entry errors include mixing up school/RCCI and student data.

>>> PAY ATTENTION to where you enter your numbers.

### Reporting RCCI Numbers

Errors in RCCI reporting occur when residential students are included in the day student count. After reporting total RCCI students, the DAY and RESIDENTIAL students that make up that total are reported. >>> The sum of DAY and RESIDENTIAL students should not be greater than total RCCI students.

## Section 3

### Direct Certification Reporting Errors

The Texas ELMS report “**Data for TX-UNPS SFA Verification Report**” documents direct certification numbers as of October 31. This report will provide you with a list of students and the type of direct certification. It can be used to calculate the totals needed for Section 3, if applicable.

**NOTE:** The CE must ensure that students on this list were enrolled the last operating day in October and identify any extended eligible students in the household to add to the list.

## Section 4

**NOTE:** The number of APPLICATIONS should be less than or equal the number of STUDENTS, unless students on approved applications as of October 1st were then directly certified during the month of October.

### Total Eligible Students Errors

A common error in Section 4 occurs when students approved as FREE or REDUCED PRICE are reported in multiple sections on the Verification Report.

**Each student approved as FREE or REDUCED PRICE should be reported only once in the appropriate section.**

- **Section 2:** Total students at schools/institutions operating ALTERNATE PROVISIONS.
- **Section 3:** Total students approved as free through DIRECT CERTIFICATION.
- **Section 4:** Total students approved as free or reduced price through HOUSEHOLD APPLICATION.

The number of students reported in Sections 2, 3, and 4 should not be more than the TOTAL number of students reported in Section 1.

## Section 5

The results of verification for SFAs with household applications

### Sample Size Errors

One of the most common errors in Section 5 is the Sample Size reported is incorrect based on the number of approved applications reported in Section 4 and sample method selected in Section 5.

If your sample size is incorrect, determine why it is incorrect.

#### Did you calculate the sample size correctly?

If using the **Standard Method or Alternate One**,

- 1. Multiply the total number of approved applications by 0.03.
- 2. ROUND UP the result to determine the number applications that need to be verified.

If using the **Alternate Two**,

1. Multiply the total number of approved applications by 0.01.
2. Multiply the number of categorically-eligible approved applications by 0.005.
3. Add the two numbers together.
4. ROUND UP the result to determine the number applications that need to be verified.

#### Did you use the the number of approved applications as of October 1st?

Some POS systems pull the number from the end of October. This is incorrect.

#### Did you round up?

Always round up!

### Verification Results Reporting Errors

The **total number of APPLICATIONS** reported in the results of verification should equal the total number of APPLICATIONS reported in the sample size to be verified **PLUS** any applications verified for cause reported.

**IMPORTANT:** If you verified any applications **for cause** as of November 15th, the results of those verifications for cause should be included in the results by original benefit type in the appropriate category.

ONLY CEs that used DIRECT VERIFICATION to verify household applications should report this section.
